Foot Locker Scholar Athletes Scholarship Program

Deadline: December 17, 2021

Award Amount: \$20,000 for 20 winners

For the eleventh consecutive year, Foot Locker will be awarding incoming college freshmen with \$20,000 funding to pursue a 4-year college degree - not because they scored the most touchdowns or goals, but because sports have helped them grow into strong leaders at school and in their communities.

GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program

Deadline to Apply: January 6, 2022

Award Amount: \$10,000

Honoring the legacy and character of our nations' 40th President, the GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program rewards college-bound students who demonstrate exemplary leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship with financial assistance to pursue higher education. The program selects numerous recipients to receive a \$10,000 scholarship renewable for up to an additional three years - up to \$40,000 total per student.

Ron Brown Scholarship Program

Deadline: January 9, 2022 (postmarked) - Different than in the past, there will be only one deadline to submit an application to be considered for the Ron Brown Scholar Program.

RBSP competitively awards 45-50 Four-Year Scholarships - \$10,000 per year, for a period of 4 years, to total \$40,000.00.

Eligibility: Applicants must be Black/African Americans, must excel academically, must exhibit exceptional leadership potential, must participate in community service activities,

must demonstrate financial need, must be a U.S. Citizen or hold a permanent resident visa card, be a current high school senior at the time of your application.

Deadline: January 10, 2022

National Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship

Deadline: Must be postmarked no later than January 15, 2022, and addressed to: Washington Crossing Foundation, P.O. Box 503, Levittown, PA 19058-0503.

Award: \$500 to \$5,000 - Scholarship Recipients must attend an all-expenses paid weekend, including transportation and housing to Bucks County Pennsylvania, to attend the **Scholarship Awards Ceremony on Saturday, April 23, 2022.**

Note: This Scholarship is open to Seniors, who are United States Citizens, and are planning on careers of service to the United States in local, state, or federal government.

The Coolidge Scholarship - For current Juniors in High School

Deadline: All application materials must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on January 19, 2022.

Award: Full-ride, four-year merit scholarship - includes tuition, room, board, and expenses for four (4) years of undergraduate study.

Notification: By June 1, 2022, all applicants will be notified of the outcomes, through their application portal.

The Coolidge Scholarship may be used by recipients at any accredited college or university in the United States. Anyone of any background, pursuing any academic discipline of study, may apply to this non-partisan, need-blind, program.

Agnes Scott Scholarships

Applicants who submit their complete Common Application and all supporting materials by the Early Action II deadline (**January 15**) are automatically considered for merit-based scholarships ranging from \$22,000 - \$26,000 a year. These scholarships are awarded based on factors including academic achievement, community service, leadership and extracurricular involvement. Scholarships are funding that do not have to be repaid, though there are requirements to keep scholarships (included in scholarship letter upon reception).

Students Without Mothers (SWM) Scholarship

Deadline: January 31, 2022

Amount of Award: The number of scholarships will be determined. Each scholarship will be \$4,000 each, to distributed in annual payments of \$1,000 per year.

Students planning to order an official transcript(s) to be released through Georgia Futures, or to be mailed to a college(s) before we leave for break, will need to order and pay for the transcript(s) no later than **Tuesday, Dec. 14th for mailing**, and **no later than Thursday, Dec. 16th to be requested for release through Georgia Futures**.

External Scholarships: These are scholarships awarded by employers, individuals, companies, religious groups, etc. Criteria for External Scholarships vary greatly from scholarship to scholarship, but generally include academic performance, financial need, religious affiliation, minority status, heritage, community affiliation, or other unique criteria.
