Community


New Manchester High School was founded in 2011 and is the most recent high school built in Douglas County. It is located in the southeast part of the county, one mile from the border of Fulton County, near Boundary Waters Park. Because New Manchester was established as a magnet school for fine arts, the school has ample resources for the arts including a large performance theater.

Curriculum

Classes at New Manchester are arranged on a 4 x 4 block schedule, with students completing four classes each semester. Class periods are approximately 90 minutes. FAME - Fine Arts Magnet Education Program



New Manchester is home of the Fine Arts Magnet Education (FAME) program, which offers concentrations in Dance, Drama, Vocal Music, Instrumental Music, and Visual Art. Because New Manchester was established as the magnet school for fine arts in Douglas County when it opened in 2011, the school has ample resources for the fine arts student, including a fully equipped dance studio, acoustically designed vocal and instrumental music studios, and a state-of-the-art theater.

The rigorous FAME program trains and prepares students for post-secondary collegiate or professional options. FAME has a variety of community partners including: The Alliance Theatre, The Atlanta Ballet, Centre for Dance Education, and Kenny Leon's True Colors Theatre.

In addition to a faculty of seven full-time teaching artists, FAME engages a host of adjunct teaching artists in the fields of sound design, lighting design, dance, instrumental music, and vocals.

FAME's nationally recognized a cappella group, InToneNation, has won numerous vocal competitions in recent years including the 2018 ICHSA National a Cappella championship.

Magnet Program Admission Process

Students in the district for New Manchester as well as students outside the attendance zone may apply for the FAME program during fall of their 8th grade year. Current 9th through 11th graders may also apply for the program. In the application process, New Manchester considers audition and interview scores, grades, teacher recommendations, and records of attendance and discipline. Each FAME concentration includes additional application requirements:

Band: Audition and interview
Chorus: Audition
Dance: Audition and interview
Drama/Acting and Musical Theatre: Audition and interview
Drama/Technical Theatre: Submit and discuss an art, craft, sewing or carpentry project
Visual Art: Portfolio of 10 visual art pieces and interview
